Sugar Daddy Snap Pea

To start growing Sugar Daddy peas, plant the seeds in a full sun location in fertile soil. Work in organic compost before you sow. Plant the seeds about 1 inch (2.5 cm.) deep and 3 inches (8 cm). apart. Space the rows 2 feet (61 cm.) apart. If you want to put in supports, do this at the time of planting. Birds love peas Sugar Daddy just as much as you do, so use netting or floating row covers if you don't want to share. Irrigate the plants regularly, but take care not to get water on the leaves. Weed the pea bed well to give your Sugar Daddy pea plants the best chance to thrive. Harvest your crop when the peas fill out the pea pods, about 60 to 65 days after planting.
